

Introduction of Division



Chemical Management Division (CMD) was established to manage the issues of chemical management that are extensively expanding in Malaysia.

Core Function

Chemical Health Risk Assessment Unit (CHRA)

- ❑ A focal point to the department officers, industry and government agencies regarding chemical health risk assessment (CHRA).
- ❑ Develop, apply and improve the methods of CHRA.
- ❑ Provide relevant training regarding CHRA to the department officers, industry and government agencies .
- ❑ Process the applications for registration and renewal of Indoor Air Quality (IAQ) and CHRA competency assessor.
- ❑ Monitor the IAQ and CHRA competency assessor.
- ❑ Process the application for recognition of alternative methods to conduct CHRA .
- ❑ Processing , approving and monitoring the application of alternative and generic CHRA .
- ❑ Develop method of risk assessment in accordance with the principle of control banding (SIRAC) for application in small and medium enterprises .

Classification & Communication Hazard (CHC)

- ❑ A focal point for the implementation of Globally Harmonized System of Classification and Labelling of Chemicals (GHS) for the workplace through CLASS Regulations 2013.
- ❑ Review, verify and determine the classification of hazardous chemicals based on GHS in accordance with CLASS Regulations 2013.
- ❑ Provide relevant training regarding inventory, classification and communication for chemical hazard to the department officers, industry and government agencies .
- ❑ Process and maintain the inventory of chemicals sent by the supplier through Chemical Information Management System (CIMS).
- ❑ Coordinate and monitor the enforcement activities by the state offices on the CLASS Regulations 2013.
- ❑ Provide input regarding inventory , classification and hazard communication of chemicals for the development of national policy.

Chemical Control (CC)

- ❑ A focal point to the department officers, industry and government agencies regarding control aspects of chemical exposure, IAQ and related instrumentation application.
- ❑ Monitor and analyze the chemical exposure control and IAQ in the workplace.
- ❑ Provide technical input regarding the control of chemical exposures, IAQ and monitoring instrumentation to Department officers , industry and government agencies.
- ❑ Provide relevant training for regarding chemical exposure control, IAQ and monitoring instruments to the department officers , industry and government agencies
- ❑ Maintain the indoor air quality monitoring instruments and chemicals exposure in the air.
- ❑ Identifying the latest or alternative instruments that can be used to measure the concentration of chemicals in the air and indoor air quality .
- ❑ Process the application of work approval to remove the materials containing asbestos (Asbestos Removal).

National Chemical Coordination (NCC)

- ❑ A focal point for the industry in implementing the Chemical Weapons Convention (CWC) Act 2005 and the regulations there under.
- ❑ Provide chemical safety and international conventions input such as the Stockholm, Rotterdam and CWC to be taken into account in the development of the department and national policy.
- ❑ Provide relevant training regarding CWC and other international conventions to the department officers, industry and government agencies .
- ❑ Coordinate inspections under the Chemical Weapons Convention and accompanying the international chemical weapons inspectors conducting inspections.
- ❑ Act as the Advance Team and Escort Team during international inspections of the OPCW chemical weapons.
